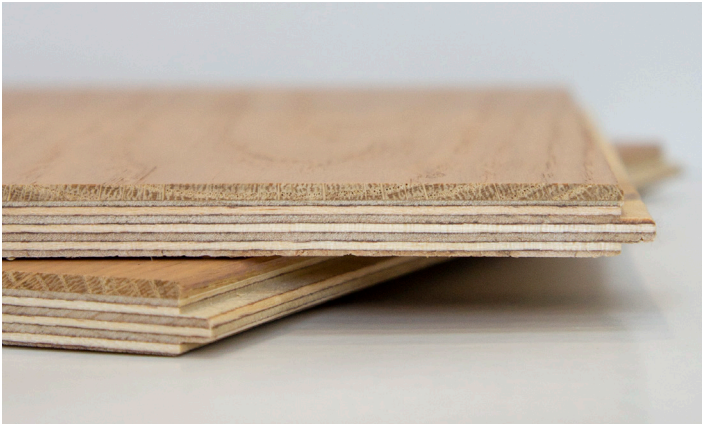


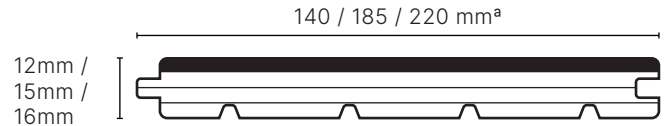

Maintenance, conservation and cleaning

Periodically the wooden floors should be cleaned by using an appropriate liquid suitable for varnished floors. Do not use chemical products, with an ammonia constituent and avoid, at all costs, cleaning with damp cloths and wet mops. After cleaning the floor, you can use a cleaning product and another revitalizing product, both suitable for wooden floors. Floor protectors should be placed on the bottom of furniture so they will not damage the floor.
